



Social Media Check: Error 400 - Manage Instagram Permissions on Facebook


1 Navigate to <https://www.facebook.com/> and login to your account.




2 Click your profile icon




3 Click "Settings & privacy"

5 Click "See more in Accounts Centre"




6 Click "Your information and permissions"


